Take Action – Comment on USDA's Reorganization Plans by August 26

USDA is accepting public comments until August 26 on its sweeping plan to relocate nearly half of its 4,600 Washington, D.C.-based employees to five regional offices across the country. This comes after the agency already lost more than 15,000 employees through the administration's Deferred Resignation Program (DRP), including roughly one-third of the National Organic Program (NOP) team. 
